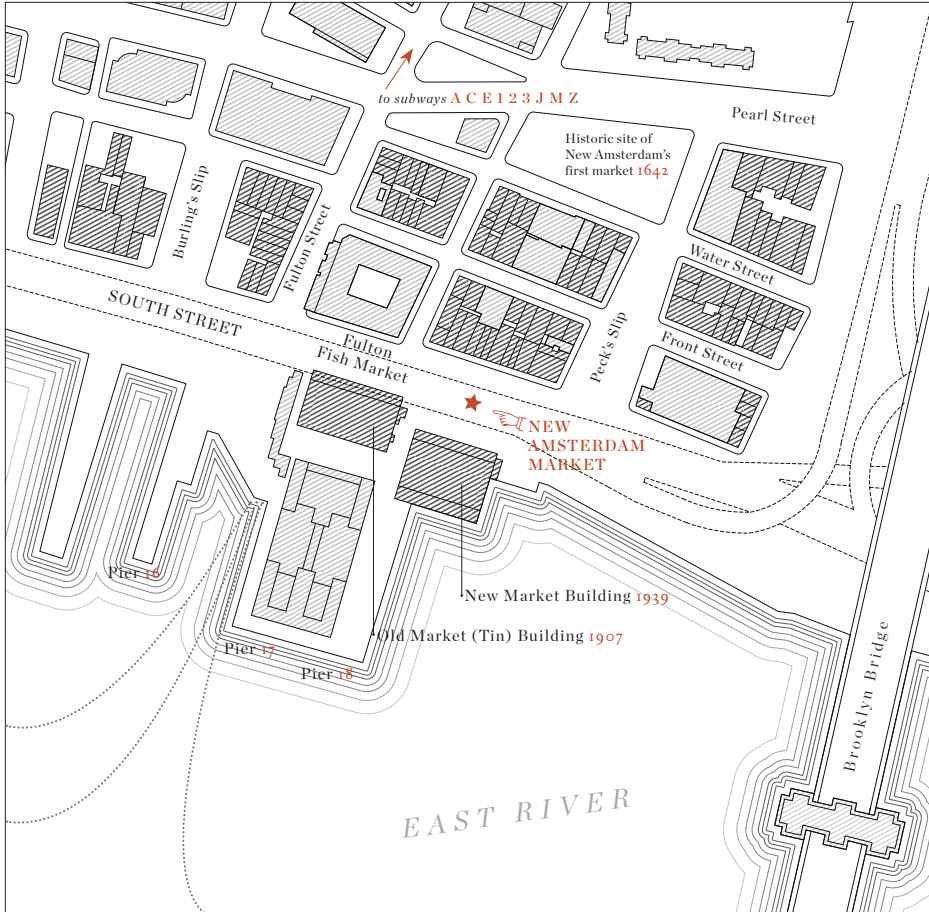


SOUTH STREET

has been a market district since 1642, when ferries began transporting farmers and their goods from Brooklyn to a landing near today's Peck Slip: the first, informal public market of New Amsterdam.

Join us at **New Amsterdam Market** on September 13th, 2009, on South Street between Beekman Street and Peck Slip - near the old Fulton Fish Market.

Walk, bike, ride the Water Taxi, or take the A / C to Broadway Nassau the 2, 3, 4, 5, J, M, Z to Fulton Street or the M15 or M9 to the Seaport stop.
